Continued Receipt of Scholarship Funds

Funds for the scholarship will be made directly to the recipient.

A scholarship recipient will be entitled to the continued receipt of scholarship funds so long as the recipient complies with all of the following requirements:

- Attend a fully accredited college, university or technical school in the State of Texas.
- Enroll and complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester. The lump sum money awarded to the recipient will be divided equally over eight (8) semesters. The deadline for the recipient to request money for the fall semester is October 1 and for the spring semester is February 1.
- Complete two (2) semesters each academic year unless otherwise approved in writing and accepted in advance by the Taylor-Odom Foundation. Consideration will be given to family emergencies, medical conditions, and other unforeseen circumstances.
- Maintain a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.0.
- Provide the Taylor-Odom Foundation with an official transcript before scholarship funds will be advanced for the next semester.

The recipient must request money from the Taylor-Odom Foundation no later than one year from the date it is initially awarded. However, each request shall not exceed the established deadlines: October 1 for fall semester and February 1 for spring semester. The recipient must make at least one request each school year. If the money is not requested within these guidelines, it will be forfeited.

It is the obligation of the scholarship recipient to comply with these rules. Failure to comply may result in loss of scholarship funding.
